Part of Profile / See Also	One or more of the following may be performed initially, as relevant, dependent on the clinical information received - Hepatitis B surface antigen (HBsAg); total antibody to Hepatitis B virus core antigen (anti-HBc); antibody to Hepatitis B virus surface antigen (anti-HBs). Further markers are performed in house on HBsAg positive samples. Hepatitis B surface antigen (HBsAg) is included in the routine ante-natal
Request Form	screen. ICE order comms form (Handwritten request – only if order comms not available).
Availability / Frequency of Analysis	On request during normal working hours. Samples are tested daily.
Turnaround Time	Results will usually be available by the third normal working day after receipt of the sample.
	If the HBsAg test is positive, a confirmatory procedure will be performed in- house, either on the day of the original test or the next normal working day. If the confirmatory procedure indicates that the sample is HBsAg positive, further tests for other markers of Hepatitis B infection or carriage will be performed
