# Inhibin B

# **Synonyms**

#### Clinical Indication

Inhibin B has been used as a marker of ovarian reserve. The level of inhibin B that predicts a poor response to IVF treatment has not been established and its value as a measure of ovarian reserve has been questioned, given its limitations.

Inhibin B concentrations are elevated in patients with granulosa cell tumours, mucinous cystadenocarcinoma and in some patients with other ovarian tumours. They can also be elevated in benign ovarian pathology.

Inhibin B may be requested in cases of ambiguous genitalia to rule out less common causes of XX virilisation.

Red top (plain) tube (Yellow top

SST is also acceptable)

Or Paediatric lithium heparin (Orange top – Sarstedt tube)

Or Paediatric plain tube (Red top – BD Microtainer tube). Lithium heparin (green top BD Microtainer) and serum SST (yellow top

BD Microtainer) also acceptable.

Sample must be transported to laboratory and separated within 2 hours of collection. Patients must be bled at Southend or Basildon Hospital only.

# **Reference Range & Units**

Values in the pre-menopausal female vary with the stage of the cycle

Female range: < 341 ng/L.

Day of menstrual cycle: <273 ng/L

Post-menopausal: < 5 ng/L.

Male range 25 - 325 ng/L.

# **Interpretation & Clinical**

# **Decision Value (if applicable)**

Reference ranges in children vary according to age and sex.

Inhibin levels vary in relation to the menstrual cycle and, therefore, are difficult to interpret in premenopausal women when used as an ovarian cancer marker.

Inhibin B should not be used to diagnose perimenopause or menopause in women aged over 45 years.

Inhibin B should not be used individually to predict outcome of fertility treatment

# **Lab Handling**

**INHB** 

Centrifuge and separate within 2 hours of collection. Aliquot 500ul and store in the referrals rack at 4C. The sample does not need to be frozen if sent either the same day of the following day. If sample is taken on a Friday, place aliquot in the frozen referrals rack at -20C.



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
