Clinical Indication	For multiple daily Amikacin desing levels should be taken as follows:
	For multiple daily Amikacin dosing, levels should be taken as follows: a) Pre-dose: immediately prior to the drug being given b) Post-dose: 1 hour after dose
	It is acceptable, and preferable, to send pre- and post-dose samples together, with one request form, but the samples MUST be clearly labelled as pre- or post-dose and with the time of collection.

Turnaround Time	Performed on the same day within 2 hours of receipt in the laboratory
Patient Preparation	Multi dose regimens: dosage should be 12 hourly. First assays should be undertaken on the third or fourth doses.

Container	Yellow top (SST) tube
	Or Paediatric Yellow top (SST) tube
Deference Dence 9 Unite	Samples should be transported to laboratory immediately.
Reference Range & Units	For multi-dose regimen:
	Pre-dose - <10.0 mg/L (multiple dose regime)
	Post-dose - 20.0 - 25.0 mg/L (multiple dose regime)
Interferences	Grossly haemolysed, contaminated or highly lipaemic samples.
	Lithium heparin may interfere with amikacin measurement.
Interpretation & Clinical	Results >20mg/L will be communicated to the requestor
